



How to find Birds Ferry Lodge and Ferry Man's Cottage.

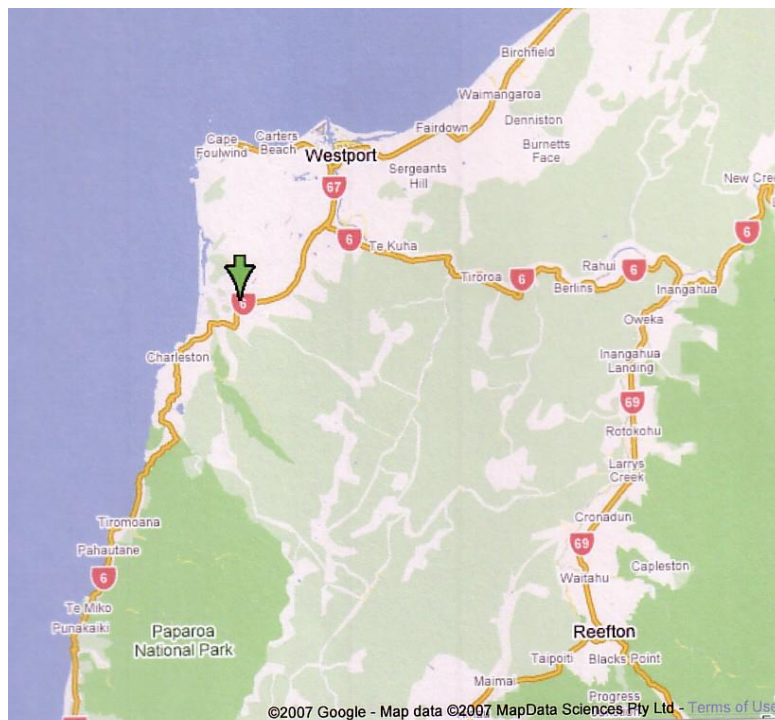
DO NOT RELY ON A GPS – BIRDS FERRY ROAD IS NOT ON ALL GPS SYSTEMS

From the South, We are 8KM North of Charleston, 17KM BEFORE Westport
Drive North on SHW6 from Charleston. You will cross the (Little) Totara River then after crossing the Big Totara River drive slowly for a further 1.1KM, at the top of the hill turn left into Birds Ferry Road.

From Westport, Drive South for 17km from Westport on SH6 you will come to Birds Ferry Road on your Right. Watch for the wooden sign on the right, at the end of a long straight section of road.

From Nelson take SHW6. Take care at Inangahua Junction. You need to take SHW6 not SHW69. 7km before Westport take the left/south turn for Greymouth (SH6) and drive for 11km. Watch for the wooden sign on the right, at the end of a long straight section of road. Once on Birds Ferry Road follow the power poles for 1.7KM. Please drive slowly and with care on the private gravel road and observe the speed restriction signs

Ferry Man's Cottage guests should proceed directly to the cottage which is 300m beyond the Lodge on Birds Ferry Road.

Please be aware that our unsealed road is owned by all the residents that live here and your speed and actions directly affect them. We ask that you keep to the left, keep your speed to no greater than 30 km per hour, and be aware that you may encounter other road users ranging from children walking or on bikes to heavy machinery.

Advice Note: As this is private land, the speed environment is not controlled by Council or the Police therefore compliance with the speed limit is voluntary on all parties.
